


# PatientAccess Registration Instructions

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1. Go to <https://patientAccess.pacific.edu>
2. Click the **Register for Access** link on the left panel



## Register for Account

In order to register for online access to your patient information, you must be an existing patient with us and we must have your current information on file.

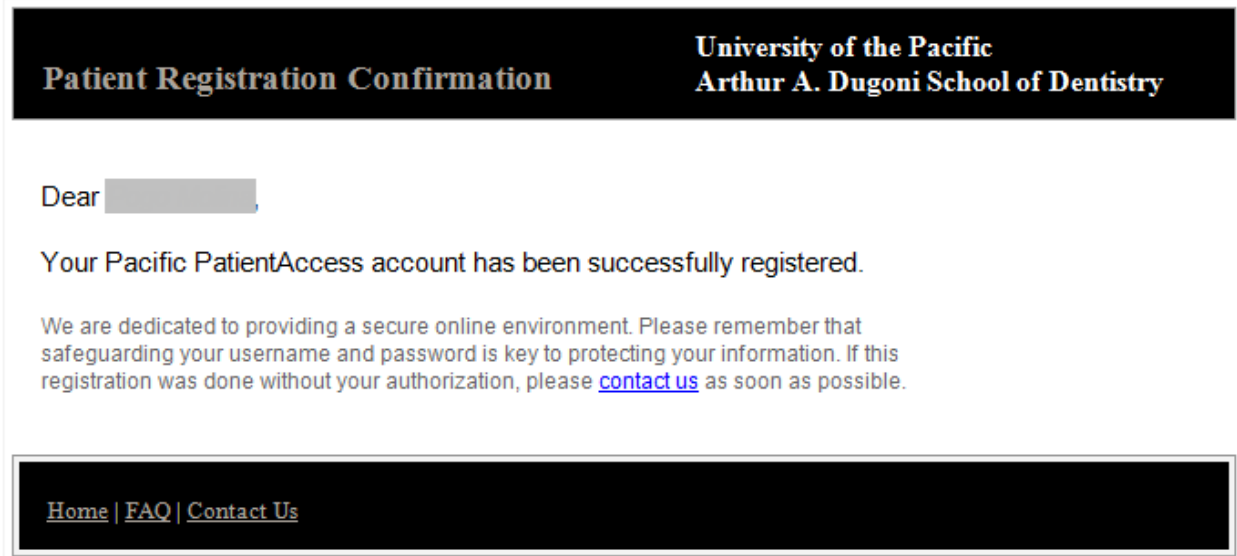
